

## Knitted Mimosa Flower

### Materials

- Yellow DK yarn (4-ply may be used for smaller flowers)
- 3.25–4 mm knitting needles
- Tapestry needle
- Scissors
- Optional: green/yellow DK yarn and floristry wire for stem



### Mimosa Puff – make several

Cast on 12 stitches.

Row 1: Knit into front and back of every stitch (24 sts).

Row 2: Knit all stitches.

Row 3: Knit two together across (12 sts).


Row 4: Knit all stitches.

Break yarn, leaving approximately 20 cm.

Thread yarn through remaining stitches, pull tight to form a small ball, and fasten off securely.

Do not stuff.

Make 6–10 puffs for one flower head.



### Assembly

Arrange the puffs into a loose cluster.

Sew together at the base using the yarn tails, keeping the tops free to maintain a soft, airy appearance.

### Stem

Option 1: Knit an i-cord in green/yellow DK yarn, approximately 10–15 cm long.

Option 2: Wrap green/yellow yarn tightly around floristry wire.

Sew the puff cluster securely to the top of the stem.
